Would a winning bid have changed the city's trajectory? Aaron Schillinger is a documentary filmmaker, whose films include the award-winning Boblo Boats: A Detroit Ferry Tale, narrated by Martha Reeves. The film is distributed by PBS and streaming on Amazon Prime. Detroit's Olympic Uprising, which premiered during the 2024 Olympics, is his second feature length documentary.
